

ISLAND GREEN GENERAL COUNCIL MEETING April 8, 2022

Chairman Bill Paul called the meeting to order and everyone was welcomed. He indicated that we did have a quorum with 12 HoAs represented.

The Minutes of the February meeting were approved as submitted.

The Treasurer's report was given. Bob said that, overall, the accounts are in good shape as shown by the financial statements included in everyone's packet of information. There being no questions, the report was accepted.

Bill called everyone's attention to the March Security Report and mentioned that the laundry room in the Arms Wide Open Church was badly vandalized. This was done by young boys and the damage was so severe and repairs so costly that the laundry room has been closed permanently.

Mary asked if Bob had heard back from anyone who had indicated at last month's meeting that they would contact law firms for our project to form a Community Service Association and he said he had not heard anything. He said he had spoken with Mark Neal about it but was told by Mr. Neal that Mr. Williamsen is out of the country for a while and was vague about setting a meeting with us until Mr. Williamsen can be present.

Ursula reported that mowing of the green areas has begun for the year. Some mower maintenance was done and she said the price of gas is causing concern so donations are really appreciated. She reported that she hasn't found a new storage place for the mower but where it was being stored is probably good for a while.

Carol reported that she has lost the gentleman who was doing the mowing of the front entrance. She said if anyone knows someone who could volunteer for this to please get in touch with her.

Under New Business, someone asked about the out outdoor pool by the tennis court and Dean Maurice told the group that he has bought that property. He has sealed the pool and is mostly doing it for the Tree Tops due to the lack of parking at the pool but he is considering selling memberships. It is still in the early stages and he will let us know as details become available.
