UPDATE Bob Zeller gave a report on the HOA President's meeting. Bob Williamsen's plans were rejected by the Planning Commission. They want him to widen Sunnehanna for a left and right exit at Freewoods Road, build a second entrance/exit, do a traffic study and fix Sunnehanna. Mr. Williamsen wants to make a Master HOA for the road repairs and drainage. There is a special Meeting with Mr. Williamsen and the HOA Presidents where his plans will be introduced and discussed.

GSPO's President, Karen Juskowich said she would not attend the special meeting due to the fact that they have a lawsuit filed against Bob Williamsen and have a court date.

Julie reported that some potholes have been cold patched. She also reported the Horry County Storm Water Management were here with a camera to examine the "sink hole". After the hole is cleaned out, they will be back with their opinion on what to do.

The Residents than gave some comments on the Road and development in I.G.

Jenny, a Rep, said she had a phone conversation with Gary Loftus, our County Rep and he stated that we should not donate to Bob Williamsen's plans because it would negate our positions with the road situation.
