The Secretary's report from the May Meeting was accepted.

Carol said Mr. Williamsen is still paying for the water, lights and mowing at the front Entrance. Horry Electric is working near the front so there may be no lights for a week.

Ursula said her mechanic had moved away and she is looking for a new one. She has three people doing the mowing and can always use more help and donations.

A Lawyer has offered to speak to the Council Board. A motion was made to allow the Council to get legal advise. The motion was carried.

Bob sent a letter out to all HOA's letting them know that Fairwood Lakes pulled out of Security and how it would affect our budget.. A letter was given out at the meeting he meeting with two proposals:

Option 1 - \$10.00 a month per unit with a Guard at the Guard House and a Rover for 8 hours

Option 2 - \$8.00 a month per unit for one Rover and cameras. There would be no Guard at the G.H.

Expanding the scope of Security to include lawn care at the front entrance and along Sunnehanna til the homes start, street lights that are not covered by HOA 's and cutting the previous fairways.

We would like every HOA to discuss this with their Members and let one of the Board Members know their decision.

A long discussion followed on flooding, Myrtle Beach Yacht new building, Phase two at Island Green. One Resident has a meeting on Wednesday with Horry Council ?and will call Bob or Bill with her information.

The Meeting was adjourned. The next meeting is October 14th 11:15 at Arms Wide Open Church.
